What is Glow Lyric Theatre?

*GLOW is a 501c3 professional lyric theatre that produces opera, operetta and musical theatre in South Carolina. Glow seeks to produce nationally recognized work that is socially relevant and that serves as a unique example of utilizing theatre for social change. We will be rehearsing and performing at the Kroc Center in downtown Greenville, SC. The 2022 Summer Festival Season marks GLOW's 12th season, and includes Elton John's **Aida**, **Classic Broadway: Songs of the Golden Age**, and Frances Pollock's new opera **Stinney: An American Execution***

I notice that Glow is producing three shows. Do I have to be in all three shows?

We are a repertory company, and use singers in at least two productions whenever possible. You may have a major role in one show, and a secondary or ensemble in another. Every contract will lay out roles and ensemble duties specifically.

How are you rehearsing three shows at once?

*Each day will be divided into three, three-hours calls (10am-10pm daily) in order to accommodate rehearsals for all shows. All roles and ensemble for **Aida** will rehearse primarily evenings and weekends. Those in **Stinney** and **Classic Broadway** will have steady daytime as well as evening rehearsals. Because of the short rehearsal period, we ask all of our performers to be memorized by the very first rehearsal.*

When are the dates of engagement?

Rehearsals begin June 13, 2022. The last performance of the season is July 31st, 2022.

I am from out of town. Will Glow house me?

Glow will only provide housing for artists who live outside of Greenville County. Even for principal artists, having your own housing in the Upstate of SC is helpful. Employees are housed with patrons or in a shared room, and given access to a bathroom and kitchen.

If cast, how will I be compensated?

Glow pays singers/actors on a three tiered contract basis. Tier one receives between \$200-\$500 per week. Tier 2 receives between \$100-\$300 per week.

When will I hear if I'm cast after I have had a callback?

If you have been cast you will be notified no later than April 15th. If you do not hear by April 15th you have not been cast for this season. However, we do keep materials on file as Glow frequently has "off season" concerts and events for which we will hire performers.
