



## **GLOW FAQ'S for Technicians**

### **What is Glow Lyric Theatre?**

*Glow is a 501c3 professional lyric theatre located in scenic Greenville, SC, that produces opera, operetta and musical theatre. Glow seeks to produce nationally recognized work that is socially relevant and that serves as a unique example of utilizing theatre for social change. We will be building at Productions Unlimited in Spartanburg, SC, and rehearsing/performing at The Kroc Center in Downtown Greenville, SC. The 2020 Summer Festival Season marks Glow's 102<sup>h</sup> season, and includes Elton John's Aida, Classic Broadway: Songs from Musical Theatre's Golden Age and Frances Pollack's new opera Stinney: An American Execution.*

### **If contracted, will I be involved with all the shows?**

*Yes. The shows open in repertory, so technicians will be contracted for all.*

### **When are the dates of engagement?**

*June 13<sup>th</sup>: Full Company Meeting in the evening. June 14<sup>th</sup>: Build begins. July 5: Load in. Performances: July 15 through July 31. Load-out of the season is August 1-August 3. Some positions have staggered start dates. Refer to the complete list of job descriptions for specifics.*

### **What will my schedule look like during the contract?**

*Daily hours vary between departments. An example of shop hours would be from 8am-6pm. When entering load in, technical rehearsals and performances, hours can be between 10am-10pm, 8 hours a day, 6 days a week. Technicians receive anywhere from 1 to 2 days off per week.*

### **I am from out of town. Will Glow house me?**

*Glow will provide housing for out of town technicians. Employees are housed with patrons or in a shared room, and given access to a bathroom and kitchen.*

### **If hired, how will I be compensated?**

*Glow pays on a three tiered contract basis. Tier one receives between \$200-\$500 per week. Tier 2 receives between \$100-\$300 per week.*
